



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO FILL A VACANCY AT THE SOUTH AFRICAN DENTAL TECHNICIANS COUNCIL IN TERMS OF THE DENTAL TECHNICIANS ACT, 1979 (ACT NO. 19 OF 1979), AS AMMDEND (MARCH 2020 – MARCH 2025 TERM OF OFFICE)

The South African Dental Technicians Council (SADTC/Council) is a statutory body established in terms of section 2 of the Dental Technicians Act, 1979 (ACT No. 19 of 1979) ("the Act"), as amended, to regulate the profession of Dental Technology.

The Honourable Minister of Health, **Dr MJ Phaahla** hereby invites nominations of suitable candidates to fill the vacancy of a member appointed in terms of section 5(1)(b)(ii) of the Act, in the category of a dental technician or a dental technologist attached to an institution at which dental technicians or dental technologists are educated and trained.

Requirements of a valid nomination: Written nominations must contain the full name and address of the institution and/or individual making the nomination, the nominee's signed acceptance of the nomination and his/her detailed Curriculum Vitae, providing at least the following information: • Full name, ID number and gender • Contact address, telephone and fax numbers, e-mail address • Qualifications and Experience • Certified copies of academic qualifications and identity document must be attached.

Disqualification: Section 6 of the Act provides for conditions under which a person may be disqualified from membership of the SADTC.
